NOTICE OF RACE

The 2019 British Youth Sailing Welsh Regional Championships will be hosted by Mumbles Yacht Club on the 21st and 22nd September 2019. The Organising Authority is the Royal Yachting Association Cymru Wales (RYACW) in conjunction with Mumbles Yacht Club.

1. RULES

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-20)*.
- 1.2 Competitors should note that RYA events will be run in compliance with the principles of the RYA Racing Charter as applicable to both organisers and competitors, details of which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020), or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter.
- 1.3 Communication with Topper (Main Fleet) sailors will be by their Championship number. Toppers in the main fleet will be expected to use their 2019 Topper Championship Number. (This changes RRS Rule 77) Those without such numbers will be allocated a number at registration to use for this championship. It is the responsibility of the competitor to position this number on their sail in the required place. All identifications of Toppers, including scores and protest notices, will be by championship number. This excludes Toppers in the Regatta fleet.
- 1.4 Female participants will be required to display a red diamond on their sail for the duration of the championships. Topper, Optimist, RS Tera (Sport Rig), Laser 4.7, RS Feva XL and Bic Techno will be provided with diamonds at registration. Laser Radial, Laser Standard, 420, 29er and RS:X will be required to purchase diamonds either before or at the championships.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Racing will be for nominated dinghy and windsurfer classes. Fleets may be combined in the event of low entries. Fleets with entries of fewer than 5 boats by the closing date will be reviewed.
- 3.2 The classes will include Optimists, Toppers, RS Feva XL, RS Tera (Sport Rig) and General Handicap. (RYA National Class rules apply). Windsurfers will complete in 4 classes, 4.5, 5.8, 6.8 & 7.8 within one fleet.
- 3.3 Competitors in junior classes (Optimist, Topper, RS Feva XL, RS Tera (Sport Rig)) shall be 16 or under on 31 December 2019. Competitors in youth classes (Laser, Laser Radial, 420 and 29er) shall be under 19 on 31 December 2019.

- 3.4 Entries will only be accepted via the event on-line entry form www.welshsailingevents.org, and shall be received, together with the entry fee, on or before 18^h September 2019. Thereafter, entries may be accepted on the day, but this is not guaranteed.
- 3.5 Regatta fleet racing at the BYS Welsh Regional Championships is open to less experienced club sailors in Optimists, Toppers (including 4.2 sailors), RS Tera (Sport Rig) and RS Feva. The racing will be organised by coaches and run on an informal basis, starting at around the same time as the main fleets, on both days.
The coaches will brief the regatta fleet sailors on the format for the day, immediately after the main competitor briefing on Saturday.
- 3.6 All helms and crews are required to present a signed Entry/Parent/Guardian Declaration at registration. (Competitors will receive this by email when they complete entry www.welshsailingevents.org and bring it with you).
Medical forms as part of the on-line entry are required to be completed for all competitors.
GDPR: This is a safety requirement and no data on this will be retained after the event.
The personal information you provide to the organising authority will be used to facilitate your participation in the event. If you have agreed to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the other rules that govern the event (the rules), the legal basis for processing that personal information is contract. If you are not bound by the rules, the legal basis for processing that personal information is legitimate interest. Your personal information will be stored and used in accordance with the organising authority's privacy policy. When required by the rules, personal information may be shared with the RYA and/or World Sailing. The results of the event and the outcome of any hearing or appeal may be published.

4. FEES

The entry fees are as follows:

Double-hander	£55.00
Single-hander	£45.00

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration

Competitors shall register at the Event Office on Friday 20th September from 16:30– 18:30 and Saturday 21st September from 08:30 –10:00. There will be a competitor briefing at 10:30.

5.2 Measurement:

Class measurement certificates may be required at registration.

5.3 Racing Programme:

The detailed programme will be published in the Sailing Instructions. The warning signal for the first race on Saturday 21st September will not be before 11:55. The Race Committee will endeavour to complete the Championship by mid-afternoon on Sunday.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available for all competitors to read at registration at the venue.

6.2 Draft sailing instructions will be available on/before the event website from 19th September 2019. Please note that these are DRAFT and may be subject to change. Questions on the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions may be emailed to paul.simes@ryacymruwales.org.uk These together with answers will be posted on the event website.

7. VENUE

Races will be sailed in the waters of Swansea Bay.

8. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward and/or trapezoid. The courses to be sailed for each class will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

9. PROTESTS

The Exoneration Penalty and the Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available.

10. SCORING

The scoring system will be detailed in the sailing instructions.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

Except when requested by or agreed with the race committee, coaches and supporters may not communicate with competitors' afloat, tow competitors to or from the race area, or enter the race area.

12. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned spaces in the boat park.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction includes mobile telephones.

14. RIGHTS TO USE NAMES AND LIKENESSES

Competitors should be aware that photographs and or film may be taken at the event, which may or may not include the competitors. By entering the event, competitors acknowledge that they may appear in such pictures or film, and grant the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures, and live, or taped film or television of or relating to the event.

The Organising Authority will ask for the consent of competitors to use their image or likeness when such image or likeness amounts to personal data, for instance when a specific picture is taken of a competitor.

15. SAFETY REGULATIONS

All competitors shall wear a personal flotation device at all times when afloat, except briefly when changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not considered personal flotation devices. This changes rule 40.1

16. LIABILITY

Risk Statement

- 16.1 RRS Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."
- 16.2 Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
- 16.3 They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- 16.4 They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- 16.5 They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omission;
- 16.6 Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- 16.7 The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- 16.8 The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

17. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3 million per event or the equivalent.
